

# Manhattan Beach Hometown Fair 2022: “Imagine the future: our pier in 50 years” Art Exhibition

- Draw the future!
  - Show us what you think our Manhattan Beach pier, the sea, and the coast line might look like in 50 years
  - All “2D art” is permitted, including paint, ink, pencil, markers, crayon, etc., as well as digital drawings
  - Use your imagination – will we have flying cars, robots, dinosaurs, or aliens? It’s up to you!
- Rules:
  - Entries are open to South Bay area students in grades K-12, one entry per person
  - Entries must be on a single sheet of US Letter size paper, preferably horizontal (see examples that follow)
  - Entries should show a view from the ocean looking east; see sample templates on the next few pages (you can draw directly on any of the templates or use one as a guide)
  - Each artist must clearly write their first name, last initial, grade, and school on the front and the full parent or guardian’s name on the back of their entry
  - Entrants must complete an Art & Stem Exhibition entry form and are subject to the rules there; see [mbfair.org](http://mbfair.org)
    - Entry forms must be submitted online by Sept 23 (or postmarked by Sept 16, if mailed)
    - Please indicate “Imagine the future” as the submission title
    - Have a parent or guardian help; the form needs their signature or confirmation
  - Confirmed entries must be brought to the Joslyn Center, Thurs 3-6pm on Sept 29 (entries can be collected and brought together)
  - Entries will be on display in the Joslyn Center with the other Art & STEM Exhibition submissions throughout the MB Hometown Fair weekend, Sat Oct 1 – Sun Oct 2, during fair hours 10am-6pm
  - Entries can be collected at the Joslyn Center, Sun Oct 2 at the close of the fair (5-7pm)
